Investment Objective and Policy

The Fund's investment objective is to provide capital growth and income over the long-term, by investing primarily in equities of large capitalization companies globally.

In order to achieve its objective, the Fund invests primarily in a diversified portfolio of equities and/or other securities equivalent to equities, like depositary receipts, listed in international exchanges, mainly in developed markets. The Fund invests in highly liquid equities of large capitalization companies which have economic activities in any sector or geographic area.

The Fund is actively managed. Our investment process is based on quantitative and qualitative assessment of fundamental factors, with the purpose of developing investment views on the attractiveness and prospects of equity sectors, along with selecting individual securities based on companies' growth prospects, balance sheet quality, level of corporate governance and valuation.







ESG Glossary

Environmental Score: A fund's Environmental Score measures holdings' management of and exposure to key environmental risks and opportunities.

Social Score: A fund's Social Score measures holdings' management of and exposure to key social risks and opportunities.

Governance Score: A fund's Governance Score measures holdings' management of and exposure to key governance risks and opportunities.
